



**BREVARD REPUBLICAN EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION 2010-02-11  
RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SHARON DAY FOR RPOF CHAIR**

WHEREAS there will be a special election for Chair of the Republican Party of Florida (RPOF) upon the resignation of Chairman Greer becoming effective on February 20th, at which time qualified members of the RPOF State Executive Committee shall vote for a new Chair;

WHEREAS the Members of the Brevard Republican Executive Committee (BREC) believe the RPOF and BREC should recognize the desire of registered Republicans in Florida for "bottom up" representation as opposed to "top down" control;

WHEREAS the Members of the BREC desire transparency, open, honest debate and respect for the Constitution and Rules of the RPOF as well as the laws of the state of Florida;

WHEREAS the Members of the BREC expect representatives and leadership of the RPOF to act in a manner consistent with those desires and beyond reproach;

WHEREAS the Members of the BREC are troubled by the fact Senator John Thrasher was apparently chosen to succeed Chairman Greer by members of the RPOF State Executive Committee even though he was ineligible to serve in that capacity at the time according to RPOF rules;

WHEREAS the Members of the BREC are concerned by the manner in which Senator Thrasher became eligible and the appearance of a conflict of interest created by having a sitting State Senator act as Chair of the RPOF;

WHEREAS the Members of the BREC believe candidate for RPOF Chair Sharon Day possesses the management skills, fair-mindedness and judgment necessary to restore the public's confidence in the RPOF and

WHEREAS candidate for RPOF Chair Sharon Day has shown unwavering and principled leadership by refusing last year to sign a Rule 11 letter that would have allowed the Republican National Committee to endorse Governor Charlie Crist for the office of United States Senator over rival Marco Rubio: Now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Brevard Republican Executive Committee:

- 1) **Formally endorses Sharon Day for Chair of the Republican Party of Florida;**
- 2) **Respectfully requests that Brevard Republican Executive Committee Chairman Jason Steele, State Committeeman Mike Thomas and State Committeewoman Carlie Rogers reflect the expressed desire of the majority of the Brevard Republican Executive Committee that elected them to their posts by casting their votes for Sharon Day at the February 20th special Election; and**
- 3) **Requests that this resolution be forwarded to all media outlets that were previously sent Chairman Steele's personal endorsement of Senator Thrasher for RPOF Chair.**

With a quorum of the Brevard Republican Executive Committee being present and members' votes having been duly recorded by the Secretary of the BREC at Viera, Brevard County, Florida, on this 11<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2010.
